Note: solutions can be procedures, instruments or tools (including physical objects, methods, concepts, or services etc.). Solutions have to be tailored to the needs of final users, also considering the respective framework conditions. Solutions should ideally be deployed in the project lifetime and taken up by a large number of institutions.
